Jewish Storyteller Press was created in 2007 by Scott Hilton Davis as a way of bringing the stories of 19th century Yiddish writers to 21st-century English-speaking readers through print-on-demand and e-book technology. Scott ’ s decision to use these technologies stemmed from an interesting discovery: the Jewish writers he was most interested in presenting to modern readers actually published their own works in the late 1800s.
